Aldeburgh's Amazing Swifts £2,085

Saving Aldeburgh's Swifts

To install Swift nest boxes (with camera system) in the C of E Church belfry and to raise awareness through a Nature board, pop up banner and leaflets of the fact that Swifts are endangered and of the need to preserve and increase nest sites.

GreenSnape Community Group £2,000

Snape Village Green

To transform a neglected and underused village green into an attractive green space to enhance the visual appearance, accessibility, environment and biodiversity of the area for residents, visitors and wildlife.

Woodbridge Creative Arts £500

Creators and Makers Showcases

Support towards the Woodbridge area monthly creativity showcase events in the Shire Hall where creators and makers exhibit and provide family activities.

Beach Bonkers £2,570

Treasuring Our Beaches 2018

Beachcombing walks & events based around Suffolk's signature shingle beaches to help people understand, appreciate and help to conserve this rare and fragile habitat. Also to offer four courses for more in-depth beachcombing, some in conjunction with a local artist to give people the opportunity to learn to draw using their beachcombing finds.
